## SAMPLE ITINERARY NEW YORK CITY PERFORMANCE TOUR

*(itinerary subject to change)*

### **DAY ONE: NEW YORK CITY ARRIVAL (D)**

Afternoon Arrive into New York City!  
Collect your luggage, meet your Tour Manager and load the coach.

*Iconic, hip, trendsetting, and ever-changing, New York City lives up to its superlatives. Underneath the Big Apple's jagged skyscraper skyline, museums dazzle with the latest collections, celebrity chefs unveil their newest creations, and Broadway continues to stage elaborate, glittering shows. Beyond the bustle, though, is a diverse population, taking the city in stride and friendlier than you were led to believe.*

Evening Arrive at a Manhattan area hotel and check-in.  
Dinner as a group in New York City. After dinner, enjoy time exploring bustling Times Square!

*Times Square is home to Broadway theatres, huge neon signs, television studios, and some of the most recognizable businesses in the world. There is no other place more exciting or vibrant!*



### **DAY TWO: NEW YORK CITY (B,D) – Performance #1**

Morning Breakfast as a group at (or nearby) the hotel.  
After breakfast, depart on a Guided Sightseeing Tour of New York City!

*Your tour will take you to Central Park where you can visit Strawberry Fields (which pays tribute to John Lennon), down Fifth Avenue past the high-end shops, through neighborhoods such as Chelsea, Chinatown, and Greenwich Village, and into Lower Manhattan. Visit the 9/11 Memorial, Wall Street, and Trinity Church. Other stops may include Washington Square, St. Patrick's Cathedral, Lincoln Center, and the Brooklyn Bridge!*



Afternoon Lunch on own during the tour.  
Load the coach and transfer to a New York / New Jersey area high school (TBC or similar).  
Arrive, setup and rehearse in this evening's venue.

Evening Dinner as a group at a nearby restaurant or at the local high school (TBC).  
**Performance** at a local high school (TBC).

*This concert will likely be shared with a local ensemble.  
Following the concert, pack up and return to the hotel.*

**DAY THREE: NEW YORK CITY (B,D) – Workshop / Masterclass**

Morning Breakfast as a group at (or nearby) the hotel.  
Load coach and depart for a local rehearsal studio (TBC – possibly Carroll Rehearsal Studios or the Dimenna Center).  
Enjoy a **workshop / masterclass** with a member of a local musical ensemble or a university faculty member (TBC).

Afternoon Lunch on own in New York City.  
After lunch, depart for Battery Park, where you will catch a ferry to the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island.

*Located on a 12 acre island, the Statue of Liberty was a gift of friendship from the people of France to the people of the United States. Today it remains a symbol of freedom and democracy. Ellis Island was the port of entry for millions of immigrants to the United States from 1892 to 1924.*

Evening Late afternoon, return to Battery Park and on to midtown Manhattan.  
Dinner as a group at a local restaurant.  
Following dinner, enjoy a Broadway musical at a midtown theatre!  
Afterwards, return to the hotel.



**DAY FOUR: NEW YORK CITY (B,D) – Performance #2**

Morning Breakfast as a group at (or nearby) the hotel.  
After breakfast, spend this morning exploring the Metropolitan Museum of Art (*self-guided*).

*The giant among New York museums both figuratively and literally: At 1.6 million square feet, it's not just the biggest museum in the city, it's the largest one in this hemisphere. On view are masterworks from nearly all the world's cultures—from Egyptian mummies to ancient Greek statuary to Islamic carvings to Renaissance paintings to Native American masks to 20th-century decorative arts.*

Afternoon Lunch on own in the area.  
After lunch, transfer to a public venue in New York City (TBC – possibly the Madison Ave Atrium or Empire State Building).

**Performance** in New York City at a public venue (TBC).

Evening Enjoy a Farewell dinner as a group in New York City.  
Transfer to the Rockefeller Center and enjoy sweeping nighttime views of New York City and iconic buildings such as the Empire State Building and the Chrysler Building from the Top of the Rock!  
Afterwards, return to the hotel.
